








# The Salisbury Greenway

Greenways preserve **OPEN SPACE**, provide **NATURAL AREAS** and enhance educational and environmentally **PROTECTED AREAS** while also providing popular **RECREATIONAL AREAS** areas for walking, biking and jogging

Look for **TRAIL MARKERS** every one-tenth of a mile to help you determine your location on the Salisbury Greenway

Pets must be kept on a six foot **LEASH**

Please **PICK UP** after your pets
