### **City of Salisbury announces its Memorial Day operation schedule**

Salisbury, N.C., (Thursday, May 26, 2016) – The City of Salisbury will operate on the following schedule for the Memorial Day holiday, Monday, May 30:

- City office buildings, including the Salisbury Customer Service Center and recreation centers will be closed.
- The City's Transit Division will not offer transit services.
- City's Waste Collection Division will offer garbage and recycling collection on schedule. Monday's limb collection will take place on Tuesday, May 31.

- Salisbury Rowan Utilities' administrative offices will be closed Monday, May 30. If you have a water/sewer emergency after hours or during the holiday, please call (704) 638-5339.
